- Access to a laptop or a desktop

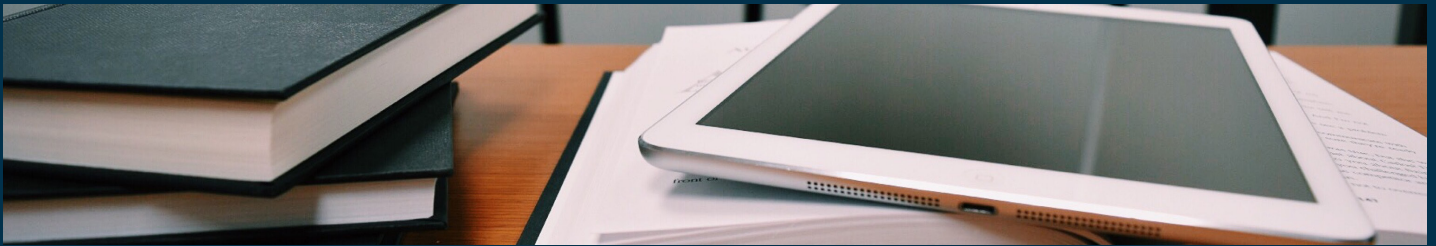
